RIDE CAMP is at the Spruce Hills Resort & Spa. \$25 per night camping fee includes use of showers, pool, and hot tub. Limited corrals available first-come, first-served. Horse water provided. Please bring people water. Dogs must be leashed at all times.

DIRECTIONS If coming from the south on Highway 97, turn right at the Spruce Hills Resort sign about 8 miles (13 km) north of 100 Mile House. If coming from the north on Highway 97, watch for the Spruce Hills Resort sign on your left after passing the 108 Mile Heritage Site/108 Mile Lake. Turn at the resort sign and follow the easy gravel road about ¼ mile to camp.

TRAILS will be mostly single track and two-track over grassy, rolling hills. The footing is hard-packed sand with some rock. Hoof protection is recommended.
