

EAGLE CANYON ENDURANCE RIDE

2021 COVID-19 SAFETY PLAN

Thank you for your interest in Eagle Canyon! Please review this plan carefully before coming to the ride, and be prepared to comply with all COVID-19 safety guidelines.

COVID-19 remains a health concern. If you have symptoms or have been exposed to someone else who has symptoms, please do not attend this event. Temperature checks may occur in camp at the discretion of ride management.

UPON ARRIVAL IN RIDE CAMP

Face coverings must be worn during the registration process.

Please be courteous to others by wearing your face covering and/or maintaining social distancing throughout your participation in the event.

All entrants will be asked to sign a COVID-19 waiver.

Note that although management will provide portable restroom facilities, we cannot ensure that these will be sanitized between uses. Please ensure that you come to the ride equipped with your own hand sanitizer and other disinfectant materials that you may need.

TIMING & VETTING PROCESS

All individuals, including timers, crew, riders, vets, and scribes, must wear face coverings in the vet check area.

The in-timer will note the time each rider enters the vet check area.

Hay, sponge buckets, and water troughs will be spaced out to facilitate social distancing in the vet check.

Riders will have crew access prior to entering the pulsing lanes. However, no crew will be allowed in the pulsing lanes.

Once a horse enters the pulsing lane and reaches pulse criteria, the rider will obtain a timing slip from the timing table on the way to the vet lanes.

Riders will present individually into marked vet lanes and follow one-way traffic patterns.

Only one rider, one vet, and one scribe will be permitted in any vet lane at any given time.

Scribes will remain in possession of all ride cards throughout the ride.

Vets and scribes will sanitize equipment between horses/riders.

When leaving the hold, riders will check with the out-timer on the opposite side of the timing area from horses that are arriving in the vet check area.

MEETINGS & MEALS

All individuals must wear face coverings to gatherings, including ride meetings and dinner. Social distancing should be maintained when masks cannot be worn, such as while eating.

All individuals should sanitize their hands and observe one-way traffic flow when entering the potluck line.

The pre-ride meeting will be as brief as possible. Riders should review trail maps and descriptions in advance of the meeting, in order to ensure their questions may be answered during the meeting.

During the awards meeting, only one person should come forward to accept each award from management. Please observe traffic flow patterns to maintain social distancing.
